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Mr.Haribabu, Chairman presided over the Governing Council meeting, welcomed the gathering and conducted the proceedings. The following subjects were discussed and relevant decisions made are given below:

Minutes of Meeting of the 6th Governing Council:

1. The MoM of the last meeting held on 23.05.2015 was confirmed.
2. Academic activities and other plans for the current academic year 2016 -17.
 - Academic Calendar is being prepared in accordance with the University Tentative Assessment and Examination Schedule.
 - Tentative Dates of Industrial visits and various events also to be mentioned in the Academic Calendar.
3. The Proposal for starting new courses.

Discussions were made in starting the new UG courses. The following courses are proposed to start:

- B.Tech.- Information Technology
 - B.E. Bio Medical Engineering
4. Academic Progress of the students.
Chairman informed about the progress of the academic results and following points were pointed out by the members:
 - There is a considerable improvement in the semester end examination results when comparing the past year. It has to be improved further by analyzing the root cause of the failures.
 - Faculty members have to undergo Faculty Development Programme to upgrade their knowledge in their areas of interest.

5. Academic Regulations and Curriculum.
 - Anna University is proposing to revise the Curriculum & Regulation R2017.
 - As per the recommendations given by the industrial experts, Python programming can be included in the new syllabus. Recommendations to be given to the University.
 - Also, Communication Skills of the students to be improved by arranging separate classes.

6. Training & Placement.

Experts from Industries suggested the following points:

- Aptitude training to be given to all the final year students so that they can clear the aptitude test conducted by various companies.
- Skill based courses/ Value Added Courses to be identified for various disciplines and to

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be delivered to the students apart from the curriculum of the University.

- Students to be motivated to undergo Internships/ In-plant training which will provide them a real time industrial experience.
- Placement Team to be formed constituting faculty members from all the departments.
- Companies in the nearby SIPCOTs to be visited periodically to have a better rapport.
- Companies to be invited for Campus Recruitment.

7. Research & Consultancy Works.

The following points were discussed and suggested by GC members:

- It is suggested to apply for various Government and Non-Government agencies for Research works and funds.
- Novel students' projects to be identified which can be taken to the next level for patenting/ research publications / research fund proposal.
- Awareness program on Intellectual Property Rights to be organized.
- Innovative Students' projects to be enhanced and patent to be filed.

8. Requirements to be fulfilled for the academic year 2022-23.


- As per the AICTE Extension of Approval, 360 seats were approved in 5 UG courses and 48 seats approved in 2 PG courses. As per AICTE norms, the total faculty members required in UG and PG is 104. Faculty requirement may be filled accordingly.
- Servicing of Lab equipments to be identified and it should be completed well ahead of the start of the semester.
- Books required for the various elective subjects and shortage of copies to be identified and procured.

9. The progress of the admission works.

- To improve the admission process, it is suggested to participate the in Education fair organized by various reputed agencies/ media.
- A good rapport to be made among the teachers/ HMs of the nearby schools.
- The syllabus was released for the first two semesters only.

The GC meeting came to end at 12.45pm and the Member Secretary, Dr.S.Sasikumar, Principal, SVCT delivered the vote of thanks.


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
