PRINCIPAL

Mr.Haribabu, Chairman presided over the Governing Council meeting, welcomed the gathering and conducted the proceedings. The following subjects were discussed and relevant decisions made are given below:

Minutes of Meeting of the 7th Governing Council:

1. The MoM of last meeting held on 21.05.2016 was confirmed.
2. Academic activities and other plans for the current academic year 2017 -18.
Academic Calendar is being prepared in accordance with the University Tentative Assessment and Examination Schedule.
3. Academic Regulations and Curriculum.
 - Anna University is proposing to revise the Curriculum & Regulation R2017.
 - Chairman conveyed that, as per the recommendations given by the industrial experts in the last GC meeting, a Recommendation letter was sent to the University requesting to include Python Programming subject in the syllabus of R2017.
4. Training & Placement.
Industry experts suggested the following points:
 - Aptitude tests can be conducted for the final year students frequently.
 - Value Added Courses to be in the recent trends and technologies.
 - Students to be motivated to attend In-plant training for 1 week compulsorily.
 - Students should not miss any opportunity of placement.
 - Letters can be sent to companies for inviting them for Campus Recruitment.
5. Research & Consultancy Works.
 - Chairman conveyed that, a sum of Rs.4,55,000/- were granted by various private agencies for Research / Consultancy works.
 - GC members appreciated the initiatives taken by the faculty team and wished to continue the same in the future.
6. Requirements to be fulfilled for the academic year 2017-18.
 - As per the AICTE Extension of Approval, 360 seats were approved in 5 UG courses and 2 PG courses. As per AICTE norms, the total faculty members required in UG and PG is 104. The faculty requirement may be done accordingly.
 - Requirements of the lab, library to be identified and it should be completed before the start of the semester.


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7. The progress of the admission works.

The following points were suggested by the GC members:

- Alumni meet can be conducted, as the passed-out students are our best ambassadors.
- The current students studying in the campus should be familiar with all the facilities provided by the institution.
- Inter School Events can be conducted for school students.

The GC meeting came to end at 12.30pm and the Member Secretary, Dr.S.Sasikumar, Principal, SVCT delivered the vote of thanks.
